

Teeth In A Day

When multiple teeth are being replaced by dental implants, teeth in a day is indeed possible in many situations. It is done when all of a patient's lower and upper teeth are being replaced at once by dental implants and a permanent bridge. There are three main reasons that help to make this possible:

1. When multiple implants are used to hold a fixed bridge, each implant exponentially increases the strength and stability of the new teeth.
2. The Teeth In A Day or full arch procedure involves much less healing time. This streamlines the healing process. Typically, since the implants are placed with teeth on them immediately, a patient can expect not to need numerous visits during the healing process. This also means in certain clinical cases that there is one surgical long day, and there may be no secondary surgeries.
3. For these procedures, specific implants are selected to make use of all of the available bone, in order to have a relative stable and predictable outcome.

Teeth in a Day implants

A patient often come with severe problems with their existing teeth. In fact, some of them may be loose. These patients also present with continual pain, and unable to chew anything due to their poor dental condition. The vast majority of these patients have severe periodontitis, therefore, one of the best options is to remove their failing teeth, replace them with implants, eliminate the infection, and stop the bone loss

Once the teeth are removed we smooth the bone and then carefully place dental implants into the jaw. The implants integrate into the bone in the same manner as a knee or hip implants, preventing further bone loss and providing a strong foundation for the new teeth.

The process of inserting the implant is repeated for each predetermined location. Using a concept of All-On-4®, which reference placing four implants and installing all the custom made false teeth on these four implants. Since this is a single visit or a 24-hour procedure, we have to have a right material that can be easily customized to fit the newly placed implants in the office or the ability to deliver the final prosthesis on the next day. Therefore, we start out with an preliminary acrylic bridge.

Once the teeth have been installed, they are strong enough to chew. During this time, a patient needs to clean around it carefully and take care to chew only soft food for the first 3 months of healing time. This is to be sure that the implants are able to integrate into the bone fully without becoming loosened. Frequently, a person whose teeth are this sick has been on a restricted diet due to pain in the teeth, therefore not much change in the daily routine is necessary.

Many patients are able to eat a soft diet dinner the night of the procedure, and when he came back to the office for follow up appointments, they often said that he was free of pain. This treatment offers patients a complete restoration solution without having to return to the office for multiple visits, bone grafting, or time spent in a denture that doesn't fit precisely, and that moves during speech and eating.

If patients have failing teeth, and are thinking about dentures, or are currently wearing dentures, this is something Teeth In A Day is a procedure they should consider.
